

## PRE-MARKET APPROVAL PERMIT

### Chapter 33: Essentials oils and resinoids; perfumery, cosmetic or toilet preparations

<b>PURPOSE</b>	To ensure that foodstuffs listed in the Third Schedule of the Food Regulations which are being imported or manufactured locally are in compliance with the Food Act/Food Regulations and are of quality and nature demanded
<b>LEGISTRATION</b>	Regulations 23 and 24 of the Food Regulations GN 173 of 1999
<b>FINAL DECISION MAKER</b>	Director public health and food safety of the Ministry of Health & Quality of Life
<b>DOUCUMENT NEEDED</b>	An Original Certificate of Analysis from an accredited laboratory from the country exporting the product certifying the chemical composition and microbiological safety of the product and in case of local products, a certificate from the Government Analyst Division.
<b>PROCESS</b>	A written application in form of the Forth Schedule of the Food Regulations accompanied with a sample of the foodstuff to be imported or manufactured in its original package. On application, the applicant will be immediately provided with a checklist for chemical and bacteriological analysis required
<b>TIME TAKEN FOR DELIVERY</b>	The permit is issued immediately after ensuring that the standards mentioned in the certificate required at the time of application complies with the Food Act and its regulations. (within 24 hrs.)
<b>COST</b>	None
