Outboard Motors**

<b>Checklist of documents to be submitted for verification of Test Reports / Certificates of conformity</b>	
<b>1</b>	Request letter from Ministry of Industry, Commerce & Consumer Protection (Commerce Division) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Name of importer</li> <li>▪ Address</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	Original or certified true copies of certificate of conformity with clear description of imported items.
<b>3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Certificates of Conformity for each outboard motor with respect to the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Exhaust emission Recreational Craft Directive 94/25/EC as amended by 2003/44/EC</li> <li>2) Sound emission Recreational Craft Directive 94/25/EC as amended by 2003/44/EC</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
<b>4</b>	Each Test Report should bear the following information: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Certifying body</li> <li>▪ Test report Number</li> <li>▪ Date of issue</li> <li>▪ Item No.</li> <li>▪ Item Name</li> </ul>
<b>5</b>	MSB will not issue test report in the following circumstances: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Any product or item which is not considered as an Outboard Motor (As listed in Fifth Schedule of the regulation)</li> </ul> <b>In such cases, CPA will take necessary action.</b>

## **Notes**

- **A minimum of 3-5 working days is required for the processing of requests depending on the number of test reports submitted**
- **Reports or Certificates that are doubtful will be cross-checked with the Issuing/testing laboratory and may require a longer processing time. In the event of a negative feedback from the laboratory, there will be no further processing of the test report and the Ministry will be informed.**
- **Test Reports where data or any other information appearing is not clear, will not be accepted**
- **Standards or specifications that are technically similar and identical with the above EN standards may also be considered if specified in the regulations**
- **No application will be processed until all relevant documents are received**
- **Payment by cash/cheque to be made in favor of the Mauritius Standards Bureau and payable at the time of submission of Test Reports or Certificate of Conformity**
- **Application fee of Rs 600 will be charged for assessment of each model of outboard motor. A surcharge of 10% will be levied if reports are not collected within 30 days after invoicing.**
- **Clients having an outstanding balance will be required to clear any previous balances before the issue of further clearance certificates**
